Agenda Topic	Outcome
ROP Reg Restriction rule	<p>It was discovered that the ROP Reg restriction rule was not in place on ROP course sections.</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Add the above-mentioned rule to all ROP course sections on the CRES/SRES screens.</p>
ENG-110 & ENG-120	<p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with Stan about building out Reg restriction rules that allow for the pre-req and/or co-req scenario (i.e., Students can take ENG-110 either before or at the same time as ENG-120).ACTION ITEM: Confer with Stan about building out Reg restriction rules that allow for the pre-req and/or co-req scenario (i.e., Students can take ENG-110 either before or at the same time as ENG-120).</p>
ES-009	<p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with IT to build a subroutine on the appropriate repeat policy on RPOL for ES-009 that restricts students from repeating this course within the same term. This policy should then be attached to the ES-009 course on CRES in the repeat policy field.</p>
Disqualification processing	<p>Initially, a Student eligibility rule was built to restrict students who were disqualified. The rule looked at a student's standing to determine registration eligibility. It was determined that the rule did not take into account that a disqualification standing is static and therefore cannot be changed to allow students to register. Therefore, the rule was changed to look at a student's PERC screen to see if a 'disqualification' restriction exists.</p> <p>This 'disqualification' restriction can be populated on a student's PERC screen once a query/saved list is procured and populated on ACDR. Therefore, if a student is allowed to register, the restriction can be ended.</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with IT to build a 'disqualification' query so as to be used on ACDR.</p>
Admissions Student Eligibility rule & restrictions	<p>It was determined that a new Admissions Student eligibility rule was needed in order to stop students who have an 'Admissions' type hold on their record. Therefore, new restrictions (i.e., ADMID, ADMRES, ADMSIG) were built on REST and added into the rule on RGCT.</p>

Student Scenarios	<p>Class members tested many different student scenarios during the LIVE Simulation.</p> <p>The following scenarios need to be kept in mind for processing OR still have an outstanding issue to be resolved---</p> <p>DR7</p> <p>When adding a course section that can be either a pre-req or co-req, a Reg clerk who has override privileges on their specific Reg User group, will encounter an oddity that must be resolved by deletion processing. Example--student must register for both courses that are considered co-reqs or a pre-req. Both the pre-req and the co-reqs are overridden, but as a clerk, you must add both co-reqs in order to delete the co-req you don't want.</p> <p>A query will need to be run to allow for notification of load change in regards to veterans</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with It to build a query as mentioned above.</p>
Student Scenarios (continued)	<p>RP4---0X Repeat policy</p> <p>It was discovered that the 0X policy was built in error. The number of times field was changed to 2 times. The policy should really be coded as a 1X policy-meaning the student can repeat the course 1 time under certain conditions (i.e., grades allowed, grades not counted), but can register 2 times. Determined that the 0X policy would remain on the courses for now, but should be changed to a 1X policy for the LIVE environment.</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Build the 1X repeat policy in the LIVE environment and add to the appropriate courses on the CRES screen.</p> <p>RP8</p> <p>Need an ES repeat policy to account for students who cannot take the course in the same term (See trip report of 4/5/05) A subroutine needs to be added into this policy to account for all of the nuances.</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with IT to build the ES repeat policy and add to the appropriate courses on CRES.</p>

Student Scenarios (continued)	<p>LS1 - LS7</p> <p>It was determined that these scenarios are obsolete since there has been a policy change.</p> <p>DR-13</p> <p>If one co-req is dropped, Colleague does not automatically drop the other co-req.</p> <p>RR3</p> <p>Additional Admissions codes were created and added into the rule (See above)</p> <p>RP12</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with IT since GCCCD would like the ability to have a message pop-up to indicate to the student that they have taken ES-010 for four times and can take ES-011 now.</p> <p>RP13</p> <p>ACTION ITEM: Confer with IT about a pop-up message (different message here). It seems clear that different ES repeat policies need to be built with complex subroutines that not only do considerable checking, but also allow for these pop-up messages.</p> <p>The following student scenarios still need to be completed---</p> <p>Staff as students Additional scenarios created on Tuesday, 11/15</p>
