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#### I. Additions to the Agenda

There were no additions to the agenda.

#### II. Board Policy 4225 Course Repetition

B. Hertel began discussion on the current Course Repetition BP 4225, the old Board Policy 518, and the CCLC recommendations. Council members discussed the process of reviewing and drafting changes to board policies and administrative procedures. They requested L. Davidson write a new draft of BP 4225 to include the Special Class Course Repeatability clause, and paragraph 2 from the Old Board Policy 518.

#### III. BP 5016 Probation, Disqualification, Readmission

J. Colson distributed the letter students are given from the Counseling Department at Grossmont College when students are put on progress alert. B. Hash stated the letter is nice, but the underachieving students he knows would most likely throw it away. He suggested the letter should be more direct.

Council members discussed the draft BP 5016 and determined they would like to see a revised draft deleting the most recent change and replace it with "Appropriate interventions will be designed and implemented at each site to notify students before academic probation is reached."

Council members discussed the time line for approval and asked that changes to be sent to DCEC members today. B. Hertel will present a "progress report" at the January DEC meeting to expedite shared governance review, and for changes to make it into the catalogs this year.

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D. Colli requested the catalog dates be verified. J. Ford stated this would allow the changes to go to the college senates in February and March. The following time line was developed:

- DEC first reading "progress report" January 8
- 60 day clock
- DEC second reading
- DEC final reading April 9
- Governing Board April 17

B. Smith asked about the council make up. L. Davidson read the composition list from the current District Governance Structure.
