

FY 13-14 Annual Activities Report Foundation for Grossmont & Cuyamaca Colleges

The third fiscal year (13-14) for Foundation for Grossmont & Cuyamaca Colleges (FGCC) concluded on June 30.

Mission of the FGCC

The Foundation for Grossmont & Cuyamaca Colleges raises awareness and financial resources for our two colleges and the students we serve.

Organizational Summary

These are the highlights of the activities of the FGCC, during the past year:

- Launched a "Give the Dream" music video that was viewed over 40,000 times. Funds raised from this campaign allowed FGCC to give \$59,634.73 in emergency grants to the Grossmont and Cuyamaca Give the Dream programs
- Helped secure a \$107,000 grant from the AARP Foundation for Office Professional Training program at Grossmont College
- Hosted the second Donor Breakfast that was held at Grossmont College in February 2014
- Secured \$15,000 from the Consulate General of Mexico for scholarships to students of Mexican decent
- Held the second annual Retiree Homecoming event at Grossmont College in February 2014
- Helped host the Brad Daluiso Golf Classic at Sycuan Golf and Tennis Resort on May 2, 2014 which netted over \$15,000 to support the Athletics programs at Grossmont College
- Awarded the \$1,500 Griffin Award of Excellence scholarship at the fall 2013 Scholarship Breakfast
- Sponsored the fall and spring Scholarship Breakfast events at Grossmont College
- Created an application funding opportunity and awarded \$15,500 in "mini-grants" for various college programs plus gifted \$9,000 for major cultural events at both colleges
- Hosted Possibilities Roundtable dinner in December 2013 to thank donors that gave over \$5,000 to the Foundation
- Sponsored the Chancellor's Advisory Council breakfast

Financial Results

At the close of the 2013/14 fiscal year, the Foundation had \$1,513,029 in total assets, \$972,439 in revenue and \$753,675 in expenses.
