The Chancellor establishes procedures to implement the provisions of the Education Code, which authorize the securing of copyrights in the name of the District to all copyrightable works developed by the District, including, but not limited to, works for hire or commissioned works.

The Chancellor establishes procedures that authorize the securing of copyright protection for works, including but not limited to registering copyrights and policing infringements, on behalf of the District.

All procedures comply with U.S. copyright law and Fair Use principles, which are linked on the District website under Accessibility and Copyright. Copyright protections are implemented in compliance with Education Code, which authorizes the securing of copyrights in the name of the District to all copyrightable works developed by the District, including, but not limited to works for hire or commissioned works.

In the development of these procedures, the Chancellor shall solicit input from the proper representatives of the college community in accordance with the District's policies regarding shared local decision making with exclusive bargaining representatives on issues within the scope of collective bargaining.
