### Alumni impact

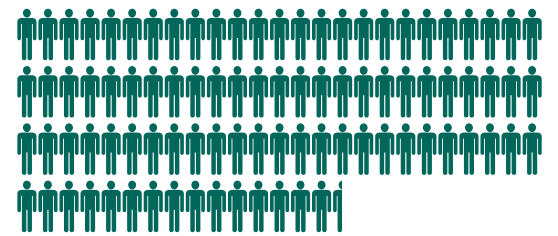
Impact of the increased earnings of GCCCD alumni and the businesses they work for

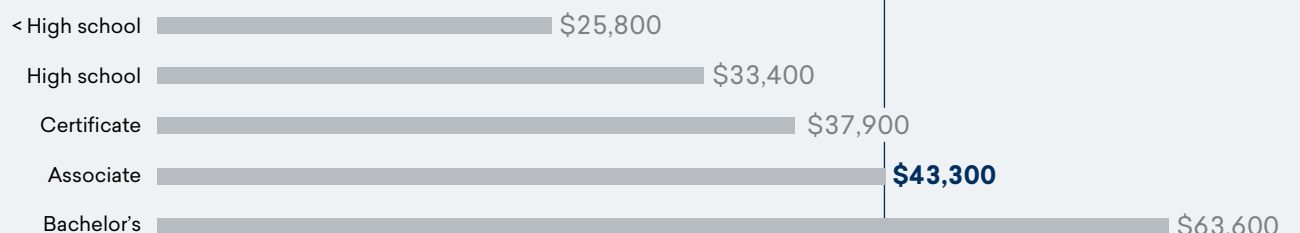

The average associate degree graduate from GCCCD will see an increase in earnings of **\$9,900** each year compared to a person with a high school diploma or equivalent working in California.

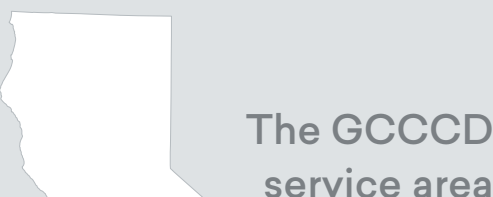
