Assumptions:

- We do not know how many students will ask for COVID EW in upcoming semesters but we can use the 2020FA data to forecast. With it being a year into the pandemic and California moving through vaccinations and lowering tiers, we can anticipate that LESS students will be affected and less will ask for this benefit.
- This proposal would apply to the entire district and colleges will not be able to implement individually. The numbers reflect combined district data.
- The sum of graded credits multiplied by \$46 a unit was the calculation used to determine column "Max Refund."
- I have only displayed grades of those students who are not on CCPG (BOG). These students would be the only ones eligible to actually receive the refunded funds.
- If approved, Petitions Committees can begin executing the same process as 2020.
