California 2014-2015 Spending Plan

The Legislative Analyst Office has produced the California Spending Plan. This plan includes large funding increases for schools and community colleges, makes targeted augmentations in other areas of the budget, and pays down several billion dollars in key liabilities. Teacher's pensions are a top priority.
