The District shall provide Student Success and Support Program services, which includes components of matriculation, to students for the purpose of furthering equality equitable of educational opportunity and academic success. The purpose of the Student Success and Support Program is to provide students with the support necessary to assist them in completing their educational goals and identified course of study through the District's established programs, policies, and requirements.
