The District shall maintain an organized program for men and women in intercollegiate athletics. The District will offer opportunities for participation in athletics equally to male and female students consistent with state and federal law.

Should the college of attendance within the District not provide an intercollegiate athletic activity desired by a student, the student may participate in the intercollegiate athletic activity at the college within the District offering the activity.

It is the policy of the Board to cooperate with public and private organizations whose purpose is to improve men's and women's athletic events as permitted by the Education Code and District policies and procedures and in conformance with the Athletic Code of the California Association of Community Colleges.

The Chancellor shall ensure that the athletics program at each college complies with state law, the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) and Sports Guides, appropriate Conference Constitution(s) regarding student athlete participation, and Department of Education Title IX Gender Equity guidelines.
