Support services and programs that are over and above the student services available to all students shall be provided in order to assist students who have language, social, and economic disadvantages to succeed academically in the District.

Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) is established to provide services that may include, but are not limited to, outreach, recruitment, orientation, assessment, tutorial services, counseling and advising, and financial assistance.

The Chancellor shall ensure that the EOPS programs conform to the <u>all</u> requirements <u>established by the relevant law andof state</u> regulations.
