BP 5430 Solicitation of Funds From Students

Solicitation of funds from students must be limited since such solicitation may disrupt the programs of the colleges.

For purposes of this policy, "student fund raising" shall include the solicitation and collection of money from students for any purpose and shall include the collection of money in exchange for tickets, papers, or any other goods or services except those goods and services that are part of a Governing Board approved program. Collection of money by outside organizations within the District, or by students on behalf of outside organizations, may be authorized only by the college president or designee. Solicitations must take place at such times and places and in such manner as approved, that does not interfere with the normal conduct of a college.

It is prohibited to collect money on District property or at any college-sponsored event by a student for his/her own benefit.

The Governing Board shall not be responsible for the protection of or the accounting of funds collected from students by organizations outside the colleges.
