When a student is involved in an off-campus offense, the San Diego County Sheriff's Department may assist with the investigation in cooperation with local, state, or federal law enforcement.

The San Diego County Sheriff's Department routinely works and communicates with campus law enforcement officers on serious incidents occurring on-campus or in the immediate neighborhood and business areas surrounding campus. (Students may live in the neighborhoods surrounding the campus; however, the San Diego County Sheriff's Department has primary jurisdiction in all areas off-campus.)

Campus law enforcement officers can and do respond to student-related incidents that occur in close proximity to campus.

Campus law enforcement officers have direct radio communications with the San Diego County Sheriff's Department, the Fire Department, and ambulance services to facilitate rapid response in any emergency situation.
