BP 5410 Associated Students Elections

Reference: Education Code Section 76061

Adoption Date: May 21, 2002 Reviewed: June 15, 2021

The Associated Student Government Organization of each college shall conduct annual elections to elect officers, including the election of the Student Member of the Governing Board. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with procedures established by the Chancellor.

Any student elected as an officer in the Associated Students shall meet <u>any both</u> of the following requirements:

- The student shall be enrolled in the District at the time of election and throughout his/her/their the student's term of office, with a minimum of five semester units or the equivalent <u>quarter units</u>.
- The student shall maintain the minimum standards of scholarship (see BP 4220 Standards of Scholarship and related administrative procedures).
- The student shall be enrolled in an adult education program offered by the District at the time of the election and throughout the student's term.
- The student is enrolled in the District at the time of election, and throughout the student's term, and is a disabled student.

Exceptions to this policy apply in the following circumstances:

- The student is enrolled in an adult education program offered by the District at the time of the election and throughout the student's term.
- The student is a DSPS student and is enrolled in the District at the time of election, and throughout the student's term.
