Grade forgiveness as defined by the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) is the intentional omission of courses in which "D" or "F" grades are earned when computing grade point average (GPA) for the granting of degrees. Under the forgiveness policy, degree candidates must meet all the requirements stated in the Grossmont College and Cuyamaca College catalogs with the following exception:

Any course in which a "D" or "F" grade is earned may be forgiven without repeating if that particular course is not being used to meet degree requirements at a college within the District, and when the GPA prior to forgiveness is below 2.0, and the GPA after grade forgiveness is 2.0 or better.
