BP 4070 <u>Course</u> Auditing and Auditing Fees

Reference: Education Code Section 76370

Adoption Date: December 18, 2001 Updated: March 17, 2015

NOTE: The District is not required to permit auditing of courses; but if it does, the following policy applies.

Students may audit identified courses as delineated in the college class schedule.

The fee for auditing courses shall be no more than \$15.00 per unit. Students enrolled in classes to receive credit for ten or more semester credit units shall not be charged a fee to audit three or fewer semester units per semester.

No student auditing a course shall be permitted to change his/her/their enrollment to receive credit for the course.

<u>Priority in class enrollment shall be given to students enrolled in the course for credit toward a degree or certificate.</u>

Individuals may audit courses by petition only and with the stipulations described in AP 4070 Auditing and Auditing Fees. The fees for auditing a course are defined on a per unit basis by the Governing Board.
