District Public Safety training exercise



The District's Public Safety Department held an emergency training exercise Sept. 26 at Grossmont College. Eighteen people participated, including representatives from the Sheriff's Department, District CAPS, Grossmont College building marshals, and members of the Grossmont College Emergency Operations Committee.

The group, led by Steve Nunez of the county's Office of Emergency Services, conducted a scenario in which a protest at Grossmont College turned violent. The exercise provided the group an opportunity to think ahead about what preparations need to be made and what steps should be taken in a real emergency. The Cuyamaca College training exercise was held on July 6, 2017. Emergency training exercises are periodically conducted at both colleges to help District employees be better prepared if a disaster ever occurs on our campuses.
