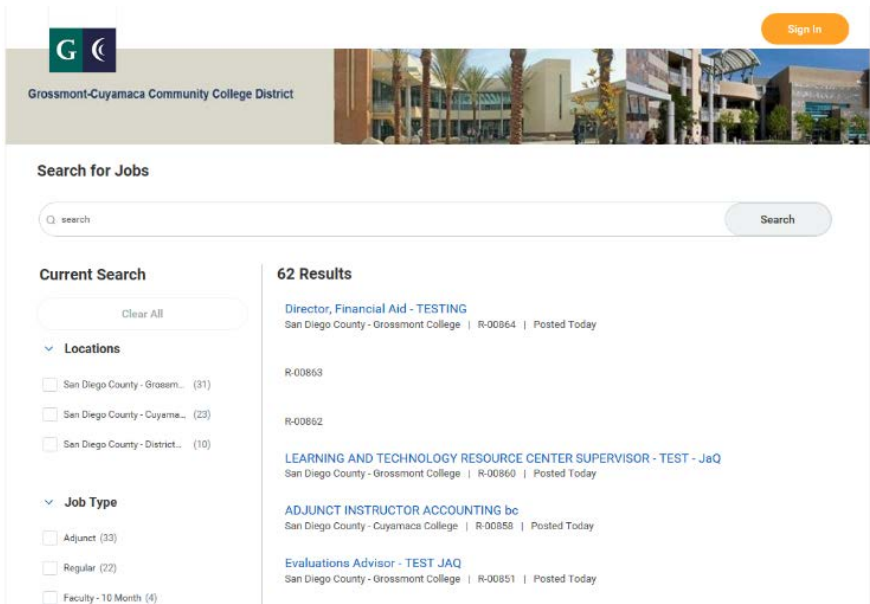




NEW HUMAN RESOURCES JOB APPLICANT TRACKING SYSTEM



Human Resources is launching a system on March 1 that will streamline the job application process. Workday Recruiting will replace PeopleAdmin, the system the district has been using.

Workday Recruiting will be easier for applicants to use when seeking a job and will improve the application process for the Human Resources team and for those serving on search committees. As part of the Workday system, job applicants who are hired will

already have their information loaded into the system.

During the transition period this month, staff and management positions were posted in PeopleAdmin until February 8. Openings after that date will be posted in Workday Recruiting beginning March 1. Faculty positions are being posted in PeopleAdmin until February 28, and applicants for those positions will continue to use PeopleAdmin event after Workday Recruiting goes live. Workday Recruiting will be the primary careers site when it goes live March 1.

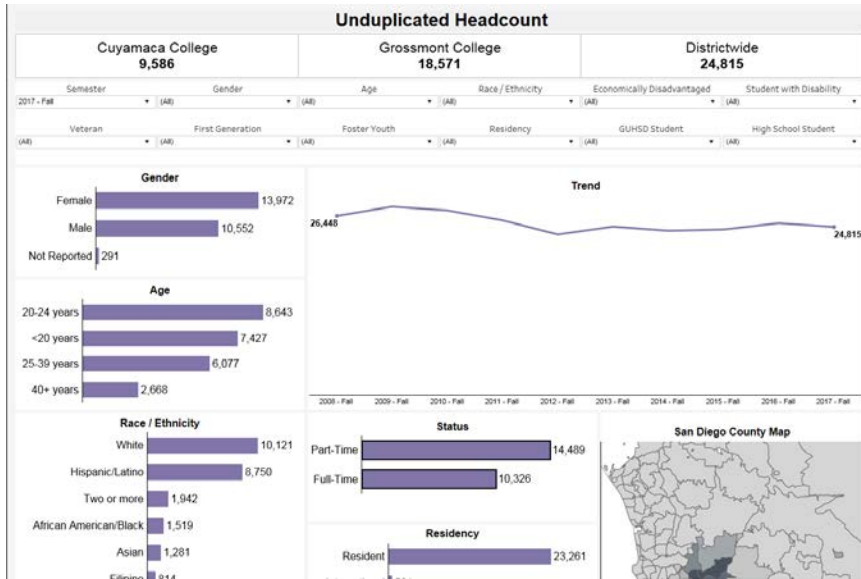
