



NEW PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR SUPERVISORS, MANAGERS



A new professional development training program for supervisors and managers was unveiled at the Supervisors/Manager Professional Retreat held May 10 at the Joan Kroc Center.

One aspect of the program involves an extensive onboarding program for new hires. It will include an orientation providing the information that new employees need, ranging from computer systems, managing in a union environment, the California community college system, board policies and administrative policies that relate to specific departments, and much more.

For current managers and supervisors, a professional development program has been created with four six-week cohort tracks. Managers and supervisors will set personal growth goals and learn in workshops and through peer-learning groups. Topics will include, management; diversity, equity and inclusion; leading, communication, and performance management.

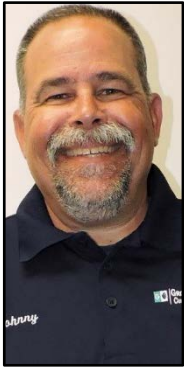
DISTRICT EMPLOYEES RECEIVE NEW PHONES
