1. **PROPOSAL**

Grant authority to the Chancellor to enter into an agreement with HMC Architects for architectural services for the Cuyamaca College Student Services Building.

2. INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSAL

a. **Summary of Issue**

The Cuyamaca College Student Services Building is a *Proposition V* funded project. To proceed with the design of the project, an architectural selection process was held to select the most qualified firm to be recommended to the Board. HMC Architects were determined to be the most qualified firm to meet the specific requirements of this project. A contract will be negotiated with HMC for full design and construction services for this project.

b. Background

A detailed selection process was done for selection of architects:

Step1: Paper Screening

- The District advertised a Request for Quote (RFQ) on June 17, 2013, for architects to submit qualifications for projects that the District is planning to construct. Reference to our approved Facilities Master Plan was listed to assist the architects on the types of projects we would be constructing.
- 46 RFQ's were received by the District. Those 46 RFQ brochures were reviewed by the paper-screening team:

 Phase 2 Fine Arts-Communications/Drama/Art/Ceramics (Buildings 24, 25, 27); and Phase 3 Building 26 and Building 21 Remodel
 - Cuyamaca College Student Services Building

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e. Fiscal Impact

The architectural fees will be determined by a pre-determined sliding percentage scale of the final approved construction budget.
