- Amended to require accreditation within 5 years

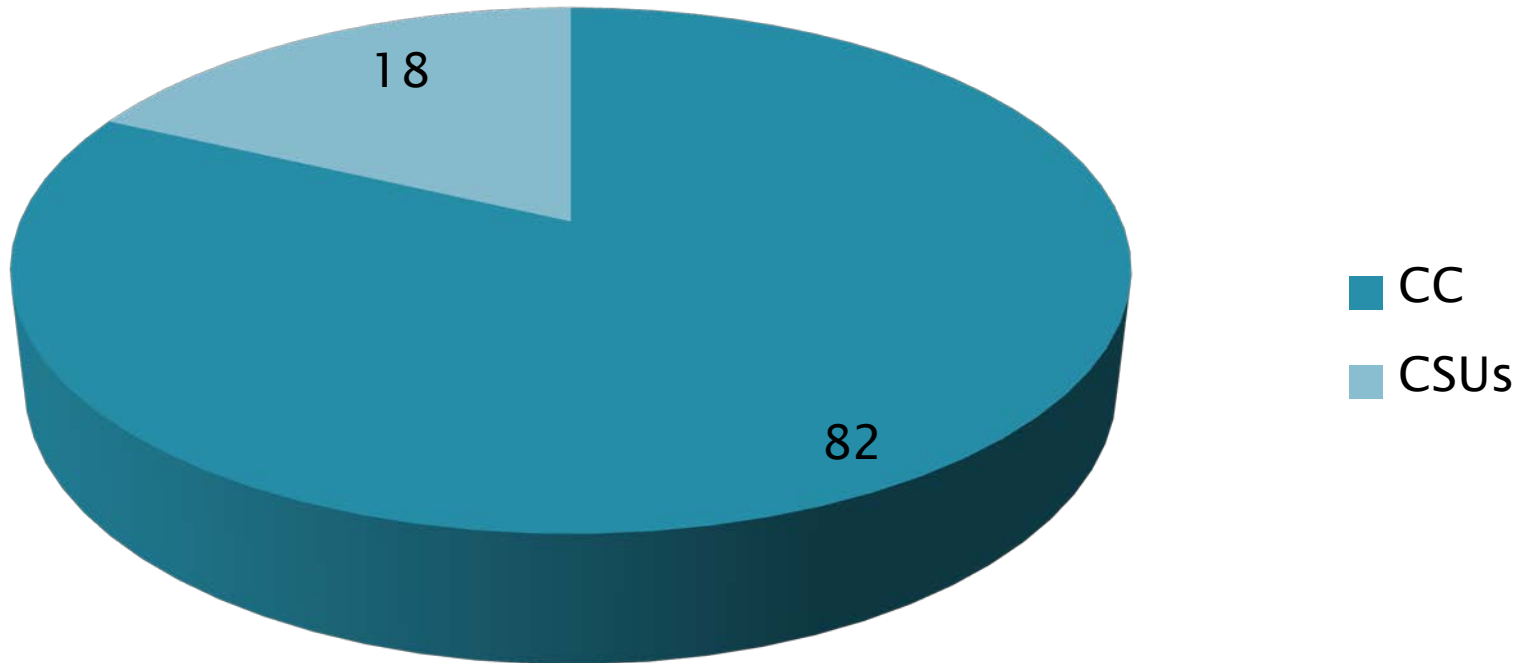

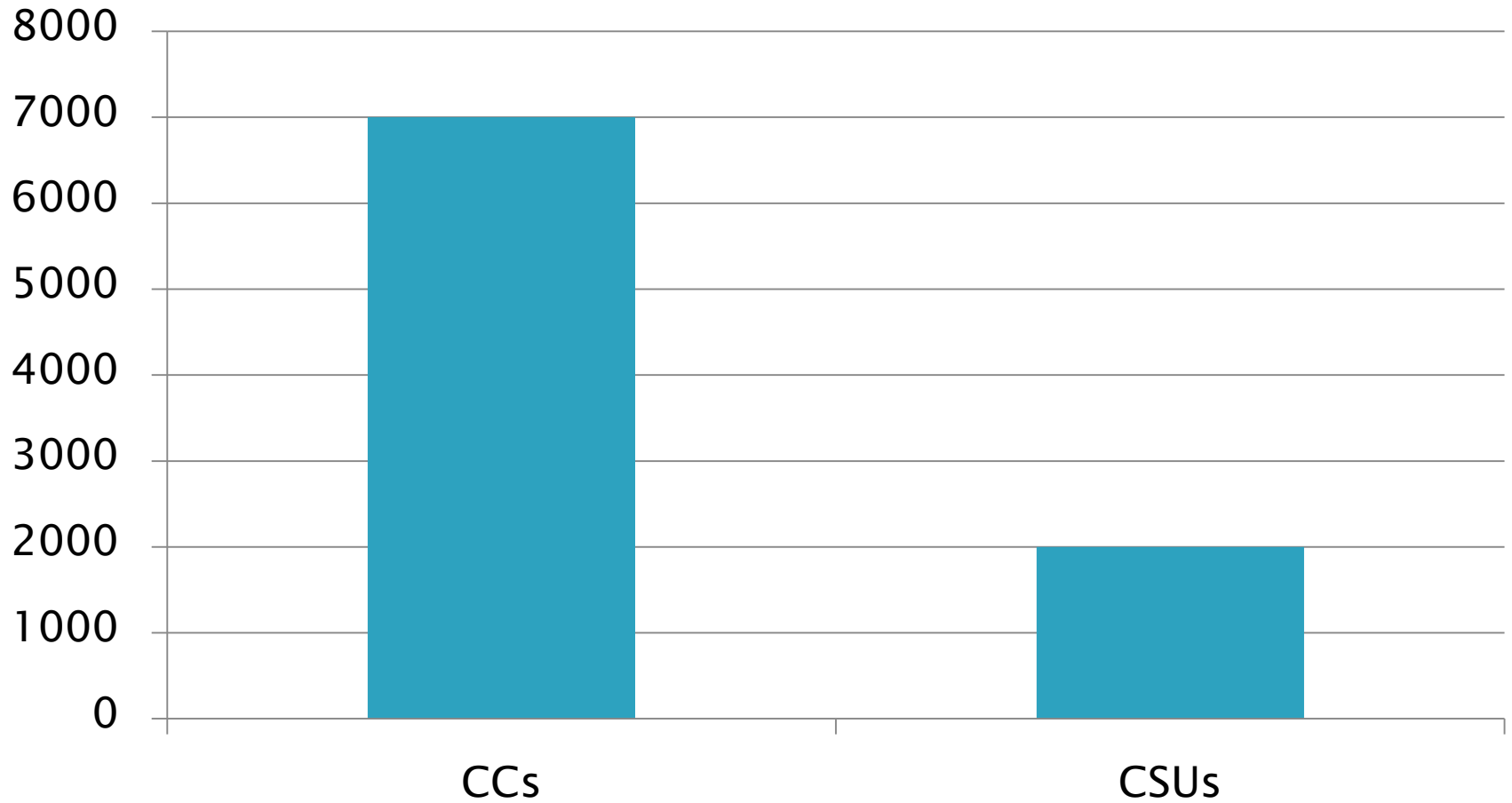

 - ▶ Familiar with campus
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
