The examples on this page illustrate how you can complete your Statement of Work. Many contractors provide a proposal, service agreement, or quote. Purchasing & Contracts must review these documents before they can be included in the purchase order/contract to ensure the alignment with District terms and conditions.

Personal Services: Services provided by an individual or firm with specialized skills, knowledge and resources not available within a department. Examples include lawyers, consultants, accountants, doctors, language interpreters, mediators, speakers, translators, editors, writers, graphic designers, etc...
